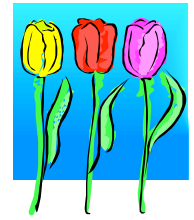




Springtime on the Alabama Coast!

Start/Finish: Historic Village Point Preserve, 27717 Main Street, Daphne, Alabama. Restrooms and water available at the start/finish. Driving directions for each walk will be given at registration.

Start Time: Sat – 8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.; Sun – 8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. **Finish Time:** 4:00 p.m.

Distance & Trail Rating: All 4 walks offer 5k or 10k. The walks are rated 1+. Some are not suitable for wheelchairs and strollers. Leashed pets are allowed.

Daphne, Alabama #83942 5&10K Walks – Cemetery/Historic Churches/Museum Programs

Distance & Trail Rating: 10k. Rated 1+. Not suitable for wheelchairs and strollers. Leashed pets are allowed. See the Jackson Oak, D'Olive Cemetery, and the Old Methodist Church Museum and Cemetery. Short distance on dirt road and path in woods.

Spanish Fort, Alabama (Blakeley State Park) #83943 5 & 10K Walks –Cemetery/Fort/RiverWalk/State Park Programs

Distance & Trail Rating: 10K. Rated 1+. Not suitable for wheelchairs and strollers. Leashed pets are allowed. See Historic Blakeley Civil War site and cemetery. Walk is on dirt roads, boardwalk, and woods. Park fee.

Point Clear, Alabama #83944 5 & 10K Walks – Cemetery Program

Distance & Trail Rating: 10K. Rated 1+. Suitable for wheelchairs and strollers. Leashed pets are allowed. See Civil War Cemetery and Grand Hotel, site of old hotel used as hospital during the Civil War. Walk is along road, sidewalks and part of golf course.

Fairhope, Alabama #83945 5 & 10K Walks –Author/Artistic Heritage/Cemetery Programs

Distance & Trail Rating: 10K. Rated 1+. Suitable for wheelchairs and strollers but has 2 small hills. Walk will take you up and down streets of Fairhope during the arts festival (Top 20 in the nation). See National Register homes, Storybook House, Sheldon Castle, and Colony Cemetery.

Cost: Credit: \$3.00 per walk; Walk Only: Free

Directions: From I-10 West, take Exit 35 (Spanish Fort/Daphne). Turn left on 98. Turn right on Scenic Alt 98/Eastern Shore Parkway (Main Street). Drive about 1/10th of a mile to the Historic Village Point Preserve which will be on your right.
