“Why Employees Don’t Do What You Want Them To” Get Certified Through Eastern Shore Chamber Business Academy

The Eastern Shore Chamber of Commerce recently kicked-off a year-long series of courses, workshops, seminars, Lunch-N-Learn and Eggs & Issues presentations. The opening program featured presentations by Traci Fenton who spoke on “Organizational Democracy – Leading the Millennial Generation to Company Greatness” and Bud Krogh with his presentation on “Integrity: Good People, Bad Choices and Life Lessons from the White House.” The February 11 event was a huge success and was well attended.

The program continues throughout the year with a wide range of professional growth educational offerings that are pertinent to chamber members. In addition to addressing business growth the Business Academy Task Force researched and identified two critical areas of need on the Eastern Shore for professional development: 1) Understanding human resource needs, including recruiting and retaining employees, and 2) How to build positive work relationships for the benefit of the company.

Two specific courses address these issues, and attendance at these workshops is one half of the requirement to receive the Eastern Shore Business Academy’s Professional Development Certificate. Attendance at any two other workshops, or the February 11th seminar, completes the requirements.

The first of these two courses is on March 5, 8:30 am – 4:00 pm at the

Holiday Inn Express in Daphne, is the “*Smart Supervisors – Why Employees Don’t Do What You Want Them To*” with Joanie Stephen.

Ms. Stephen will address why workplace turnover is costly and how it affects productivity. Often there is a disconnect between supervisors and employees. Supervisors don’t understand why employees don’t just do their job and they become defensive, or they just leave.

Based on Workplace Essentials, a program developed by the Workforce Development Program at Boise State University,

understanding how to address current problems, motivate workers, reduce turnover and bring the unit to a new level of accomplishment will provide the supervisor with new skills that address today’s workplace, including Generation Y.

This workshop is sponsored by Hutchinson, Moore & Rauch LLC.

The second of the two courses is “*Hiring, Firing and Everything in Between*” with Stephanie Constantine and will also offer HR CEUs. This course is scheduled for June 4, 8:30 – 4:00 pm. The location is to be determined. It is
