Prepare to Grow!

Governor Bob Riley Speaks to Community Leaders

The Eastern Shore Chamber of Commerce Economic Development Council (EDC) recently held a special Economic Development conference and presented Governor Bob Riley as the keynote speaker. The event was held on July 12 at the Five Rivers Delta Resource Center in Spanish Fort. Invited guests included partners of the Chamber’s Blueprint for Tomorrow (BFT) strategic plan, board of directors and board of advisors. The meeting was an opportunity for the Chamber to report progress on accomplishing the goals of the BFT.

Joe Bullock, past vice chairman of the Council, opened the program with a special thanks to the sponsors of the event: Hancock Bank, Mobile Gas, Baldwin EMC and Huntington College. Also thanked was Five Rivers Delta Resource Center for hosting the conference. He then introduced Diane Anderson, who is the incoming vice chairman.

Anderson welcomed the guests and introduced the various chairs of the task forces that make up the Economic Development Council: Scott Koser, chair of the Technology/Research Park Task Force; Paige Thatcher, chair of the Transportation Task Force; Eric Nager, chair of the Business Academy Task Force; and Jim Byrd, chair of the Business Survey Task Force.

Strong economic growth is coming to lower Alabama. Gov. Riley told the



group the future is bright for the entire region. He encouraged everyone to stay involved and united in the planning and decision making process to ensure quality growth.

Two examples of strong economic growth Riley cited were the steel mill planned in Mobile County and the USA Mitchell Cancer Center. Riley noted that more such economic growth will impact the area in the near future. He teased the crowd by saying he will soon be announcing a new business in south Alabama that will be every bit as exciting.

“There’s a lot going on, but nowhere in Alabama do you have more economic opportunity than

you do in the two most southern counties,” he said.

Riley also mentioned that royalties from natural gas wells offshore in the
